Choose Pharmacy First

It is faster and more convenient to see your pharmacist for common complaints including backache, constipation, eye infections, skin infections, sore throat, vaginal thrush and many others.

Dental problems

Please don't call us – call your dentist, NHS Direct or 111 instead.

Prescription Requests

We do not take telephone requests for repeat medication. Please use online prescription ordering as it is the most efficient system. You can sign up at reception (you will need to provide your email address).

Please allow 72 hours working time between requesting your prescription and collecting it from the pharmacy.

Advanced Nurse and Paramedic Practitioners

We are fortunate to have these experienced clinicians working as part of the practice team. They are trained to assess patients, diagnose illness and prescribe treatments. They can also refer patients when needed for investigations and on to the hospital for further care as required.

Sleeping tablets and morphine based painkillers

We are committed to reducing our use of these medications in line with the NHS Wales plan. We do not recommend sleeping tablets at all – even for short courses. We do not recommend morphine medications for chronic pain as they have been shown not to work and cause harm.

If you are already dependent on these medications we will not suddenly stop them as withdrawal can occur. We will assist you to gradually reduce, usually over a period of several months.
